Library Pages

Pages process items, check out books, shelve books, and more! We recruit pages regularly. Pages must be at least 16 to apply for a job at the library. Pages work 8-24 hours per week and are eligible for limited benefits. Check cityofmadison.com/jobs for listings.





Librarians

Some librarians work at a reference desk answering questions, others plan and put on programs inside or outside the library. Our librarians are skilled professionals, ready to answer any question you have! Librarian positions typically require a Master's degree.

Library Assistants

Library assistants work at customer service desks, implement programs, organize library collections, and do outreach work. Library Assistant positions typically require at least two years of college.

Volunteering at the library is a great way to earn a letter of recommendation and reference for future employment, scholarship and college applications, and more. Volunteers aged 12+ should contact their local library for opportunities.
